## PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Dr David Kariuki Muigua is a distinguished law scholar, Environmental Consultant, an accomplished mediator and a Chartered arbitrator. He is a holder of a Ph. D in law from the University of Nairobi and with widespread training and experience in both international and national commercial arbitration and mediation.

He is recognised nationally and globally, with the *Chambers and Partners* rating him as one of the best dispute resolvers in the country.
